- Be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen OR holder of a Permanent Visa and permanently residing in Queensland.
- Be 15 years of age or older.
- Have finished secondary school or left school.
- Not hold or be currently undertaking a Certificate III or higher qualification. This does not include qualifications undertaken while at secondary school.

People with disabilities or of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent are encouraged to apply.

The student tuition fees, as published, are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment.
